## REGULAR MEETING

## **JANUARY 8, 2007**

The first regular meeting of the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Ogdensburg, Sussex County, New Jersey was held in the Council Chambers of the Borough Hall on January 8, 2007.

Mayor Sekelsky called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M.

Upon roll Call, the following council members appeared and answered the call: Altenburg, Hann, Kociuba, Ingerto, Peist. Absent: Szonyi.

Notice requirements of P.L. 1975, Ch, 231, Sec., 4 and 13 have been satisfied with a schedule of all meetings, together with the time, location and agenda of same being sent to the NEW JERSEY HERALD and NEW JERSEY SUNDAY HERALD and posted on the bulletin board January 2, 2007.

Councilman Peist moved, Councilman Altenburg seconded, motion for approval of membership for Anthony Rowett, Jr. and Cory Houghtaling into the New Jersey State Firemen's Association. Yeas: Altenburg, Hann, Ingerto, Kociuba, Peist.

Borough Planner, Fred Suljic came before council to discuss the Highlands Land Use Capability Map. Mr. Suljic noted that there are numerous inaccuracies in the Use Capability Map. Mr. Suljic will present an updated map to the Borough on the Highland Council, which will show existing developments and projected lands to be developed in accordance with the Borough's zoning and master plan. Mr. Suljic will meet with representatives of the Borough Land Use Board and Borough Council at the end of the month to review the revised map, which he would transmit to the Highland Council before the public comment period is over. Mr. Suljic informed Mayor and Council that he feels it should take him between 10-15 hours and his rate of pay is \$50.00/hr. Mr. Suljic announced that there would be a public hearing on the Highlands on January 18, 2007 at the Sussex County Technical School at 4:00 p.m.

Councilman Altenburg moved, Councilman Hann seconded a motion to authorize Mr. Fred Suljic to update the Regional Master Plan Land Use Capability Map for the Borough of Ogdensburg at a rate of \$50.00 per hour for 10-15 hours. Yeas: Altenburg, Hann, Ingerto, Peist.

Councilman Ingerto spoke to Ken Smith, Supervisor of the Department of Public Works about the bulletin board at the Fire House. The letters are broken and the sign itself is falling apart. Ken Smith has contacted a company to inquire about purchasing a new sign. Councilman Altenburg informed Mayor and Council that he is working on the dug out and backdrop at the field.
