

**BOROUGH OF OGDENSBURG  
ORDINANCE NO. 06-2021**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 7 OF  
THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF OGDENSBURG ENTITLED  
“TRAFFIC” TO REGULATE MAXIMUM GROSS VEHICLE WEIGHT ON  
CERTAIN PUBLIC STREETS**

WHEREAS, the Borough of Ogdensburg (“Borough”) desires to regulate the maximum gross vehicle weight (GVW) on certain public streets located within the Borough in order to promote public health, safety, and welfare.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Ogdensburg, in the County of Sussex, and State of New Jersey that Chapter 7 of the Code of the Borough of Ogdensburg entitled “Traffic” is hereby amended as follows:

**SECTION I.** Section 7-20 entitled “Vehicles Over Designated Weight Excluded from Certain Streets” is hereby replaced as follows:

**§7-20 VEHICLES OVER DESIGNATED WEIGHT EXCLUDED FROM CERTAIN  
STREETS**

Vehicles over the gross vehicle weight (GVW) are hereby excluded from the streets or parts of streets described except for the pickup and delivery of materials on such streets.

Name of Street	Weight	Limit
Trucks Over 4 Tons		
Brooks Flat Road	Over 4 tons	From Main Street to Plant Street
Edison Avenue	Over 4 tons	From Main Street to Sparta Township Line
Highland Avenue	Over 4 tons	From Main Street to Edison Avenue
Kennedy Avenue	Over 4 tons	From Main Street to Corkhill Road
Passaic Avenue	Over 4 tons	From Main Street to Sparta Township Line
Plant Street	Over 4 tons	From Brooks Flat Road to Passaic Avenue
Spring Street	Over 4 tons	From Main Street to Edison Avenue


**SECTION II.** If any article, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is, for any reason, held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance and they shall remain in full force and effect.


**SECTION III.** In the event of any inconsistencies between the provisions of this Ordinance and any prior ordinance of the Borough, the provisions hereof shall be determined to

govern. All other ordinances of the Borough are hereby ratified and confirmed, except where inconsistent with the terms hereof.

**SECTION IV.** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication according to law.
